# **National Contact Points (NCPs)**



### **National Contact Points are**

- Persons giving personalized support in all related questions regarding the participation in the Framework Programme (e.g. Info on Calls, support in the preparation of project proposals, project negotiation etc.)
- Established in each EU member State, Associated Country (e.g. Switzerland) and in some International Cooperation Partner Countries (ICPCs, e.g. Ukraine)
- Mostly financed by national governments
- First address when it comes to questions related to the Framework Programme


